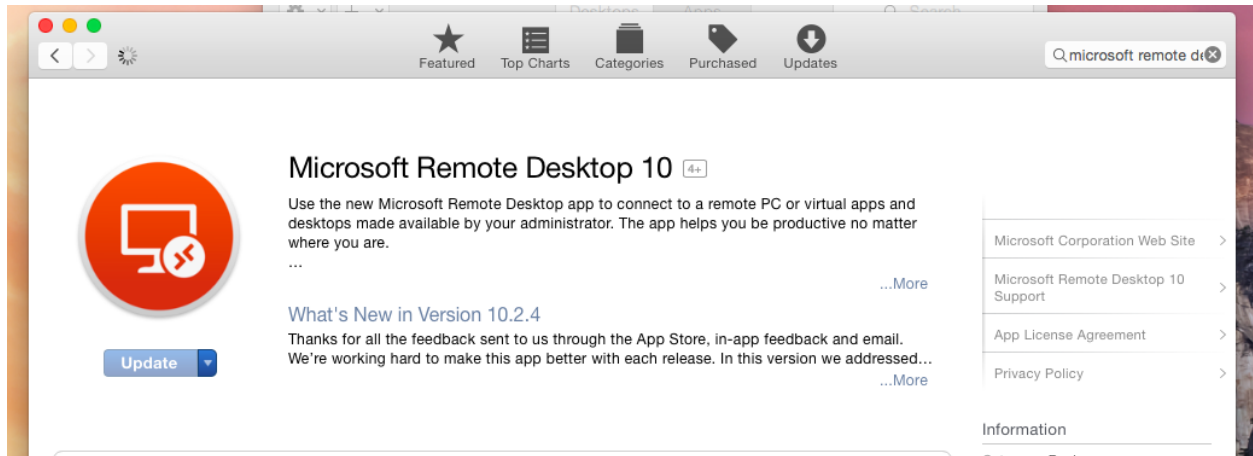
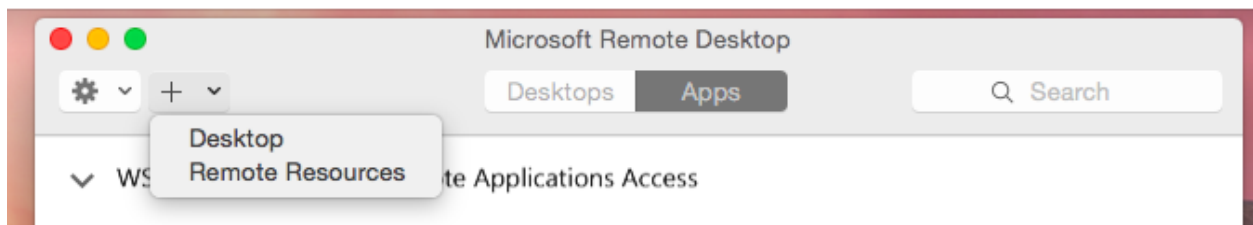


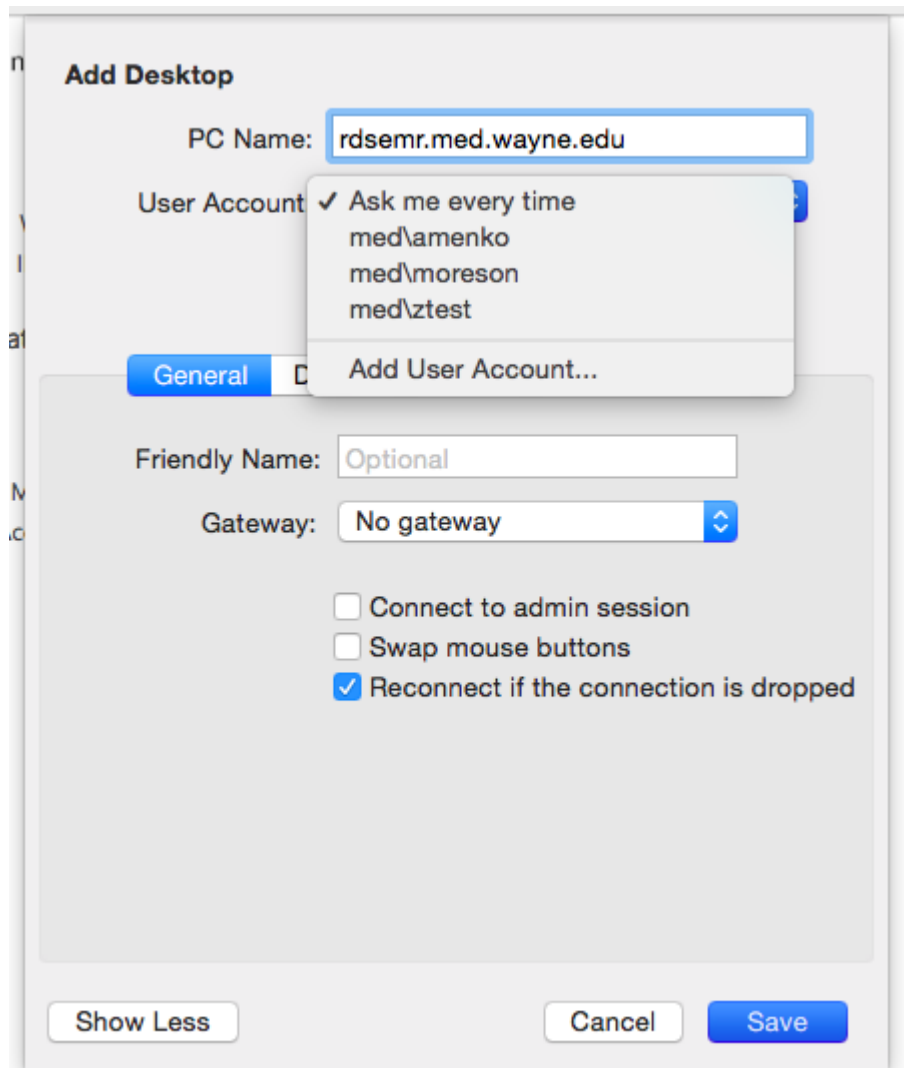
On your Mac, go to the App Store and search for **Microsoft Remote Desktop** and install **Microsoft Remote Desktop 10** (other versions will not work)



Once installed, go ahead and launch the program. Click on the Plus sign on the top left and click on *Desktop*



In the PC Name field type **rdsemr.med.wayne.edu** then click on the blue arrow across from *User Account* and click on "Add User Account"



In the *User Name* field put **med** and your MED ID (the ID you use to log onto our computers such as "asmith") then in the *Password* field input the associated password & click Save.

This will take us back to the *Add Desktop* window. Go down and click on the blue arrow across from *Add Gateway* and select **Add Gateway** again. In the *Add Gateway* window you will input **rdsgw.med.wayne.edu** for the *Server Name*. Then across from *User Account* click on the blue arrow and select your MED ID from the dropdown and click *Save*.
